The Civil Division of the Snohomish County Prosecuting Attorney's office seeks an attorney with a minimum of 8 years municipal law experience representing and advising public officials and entities. This position provides comprehensive legal services to the county and leadership at Paine Field on a broad variety of legal matters, excluding land use, employment, and tort claims. Duties include conducting legal research, providing oral and written legal advice, drafting contracts and other legal instruments, developing legislation, and representing Snohomish County and its officials in litigation. The preferred candidate will have substantial experience working with and advising clients on real estate matters. Experience with airport legal issues is desired, but not required.

Applicants should have a strong interest in public and administrative law; excellent research, analysis, and communication skills; and experience in computer-aided research and word processing. The ability to work with other attorneys, support staff, and county personnel is essential. Membership in the Washington State Bar Association is required upon hiring. In accordance with state law, deputy prosecuting attorneys must be United States citizens.
