POSTING: The Prosecutor's Office has a Deputy position opening up in mid- to late-August, and is seeking qualified, interested applicants.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Responsibilities will include: representing the State in misdemeanor and some juvenile and felony cases (including case reviews, charging decisions, pretrial hearings, negotiations, trial organization, and trial); appeals (including briefs and potentially oral argument); prosecuting infractions; representing the State in truancies, contempt hearings, parentage, and child support actions; and miscellaneous research and civil projects as required. The Deputy Prosecutor will also act as Deputy Coroner for the County (training will be available).

REQUIREMENTS: Must be admitted to the Washington State Bar Association. Must have knowledge of the laws of the State of Washington, rules of evidence and procedure, Washington Court Rules, and Washington Rules of Professional Conduct and ethical standards.

Must be able to operate standard office equipment, including telephones, computers, and copy and fax machines. Must have the ability to drive and to travel to locations outside of the office or the courthouse.
